The PBLMD Project was funded with the support of the European Union within the Erasmus+ program for the period October 15, 2015 to October 14, 2019. Aalborg University was the Applicant and Coordinator of the PBLMD Project.

The total project budget was €1,544,760, of which €657,275 was earmarked for student and staff mobility. The project aimed to improve quality of teaching and learning methodologies and university education programmes in Moldova while enhancing their relevance for the labour market and disadvantaged groups in the society. PBLMD intention was to introduce new, innovative (for the context of Moldovan universities) teaching and learning methodologies and tools, such as Problem Based Learning (PBL), Enquiry Based Learning (EBL) and Simulations and re-designing 6 study programmes on the basis of such methods in 6 universities.

The project also had a special mobility strand under which Bachelor students and academic staff from Moldova would travel to EU project partners for study and training.
